**1번입니다.**

대화를 듣고, 여자가 사려고 하는 옷을 고르세요.

W: Jack, what would be a good present for Cathy's birthday?

M: You know I'm not good at buying presents for girls. Do you have anything in mind?

W: I'm thinking about a dress, but I can't find the perfect one for her.

M: Look! A new children's clothing store is here. Do you want to look around?

W: Oh, look at the dress in the display window! It's so lovely!

M: Which one? The one with a belt?

W: No, not that one. The one with a big ribbon around the waist.

M: You mean the plain ribbon?

W: No, the striped ribbon. Don't you think it's so cute?

M: Oh, that one. Yeah. I think she will look pretty in that dress.

W: Right! I'll buy it.

**2번입니다.**
