ANN : 이제 시작하겠습니다.

1번입니다.

대화를 듣고, 환자에게 도움이 되지 않는 것을 고르세요.

W: You seem to have a serious problem.

M: Yes, I think so. What should I do?

W: I'll prescribe some medicine for you. Take two pills of this medicine after each meal. Plus, have an apple before breakfast and drink a lot of water between meals.

M: What else can I do?

W: Don't forget to have bananas after dinner. Be careful not to drink coffee or green tea. Caffeine will make your problem worse.

2번입니다.

W: May I help you?

W: Do you have the receipt?

W: Would you like to exchange it for another one?

M: Sure, as long as the zipper works.

W: We don't have the same color. How about the brown one?

M: I don't like that color.

W: If you can wait a week, I can order the same color. Would you like to wait or get your money back?

W: I don't like scary movies. I'm more into romantic movies.

M: No way! I hate that kind of stuff!

W: Really? Well then, what kind of movies do you like?

M: I love action and adventure.

W: Oh yeah? Well, I guess they are okay, but are there any other good movies?

M: Yes, there is a mystery movie that came out last week. I heard it's pretty good.

W: I guess that doesn't sound too bad. I'll buy the tickets online.
