외국어(영어) 영역 듣기 대본**

1. 대화를 듣고, 여자가 구입할 선풍기를 고르시오.

M: Hello. Can I help you find something?

W: Yes, I'm looking for a portable fan.

M: Okay. We have many different types of portable fans over here.

W: Great. Can you recommend one for me?

M: What do you think of this bicycle-shaped one? It has a fun design.

W: It's interesting but looks a little childish. I'd like to buy a more typical one.

M: Then, what about this circle-shaped one or that square-shaped one?

W: Both are okay, but I prefer the square one.

M: That's a good choice. Square fans are very popular nowadays. This model comes with or without a remote control.

W: I don't need a remote control, so I'll take the one without it.

3. 다음을 듣고, 여자가 하는 말의 주제로 가장 적절한 것을 고르시오.

W: Last time, we learned about the benefits of drinking tea. Today, we'll talk about plant-based food consumption. First, plant-based foods such as fruit, vegetables, and grain help us stay healthy by lowering blood pressure and cholesterol. A plant-based diet also saves an enormous number of animals from being killed by the meat industry. Less demand for meat leads to a decrease in the number of livestock raised for food. This in turn reduces the amount of methane gas and waste the animals produce. In short, by following a plant-based diet we can stay healthy, save the animals, and protect the environment.
