ANN : 이제 시작하겠습니다.

1번입니다.

대화를 듣고, 학급 문집의 표지로 가장 알맞은 것을 고르세요.

M: Our job is to design our class year book cover. How about putting the title on the top center? It's quite common, you know.

W: Well, we can make it a little different, like placing it in the very middle.

M: Then we won't have space for our picture.

W: We can use the picture as a background.

M: Oh, that's a good idea. Then what kind of picture do you like?

W: Hmm. What about using the school picture?

M: Well, it's for our class, so I think it's better to use our class picture.

W: Great. Let's go for it!

2번입니다.

대화를 듣고, 추석 다음 날의 날씨를 고르세요.

W: Minho, are you going to your hometown for Chuseok?

M: No. I have only three days off from Friday to Sunday, and I heard it is going to rain heavily.

W: Rain for all three days?

M: No, the weather will be fine on Friday. It will be windy and rainy on Chuseok, which falls on Saturday this year.

M: When will you come back?

W: Sunday afternoon.

M: You don't have to worry about it. On Sunday it will just be cloudy.

3번입니다.

대화를 듣고, 대화가 이루어지고 있는 장소를 고르세요.

W: Hey, Tom. What a surprise to see you here! I thought you had already left for China.

M: Not yet. I'm leaving next week. Are you on your way home now?

W: No, I'm going to the department store. Tomorrow's my mom's birthday.

M: What are you going to buy?

W: I'm not sure. I'll go and see. Where are you going?

M: I'm going to the bookstore to buy some books about China.

W: Oh, I have to get off at the next stop. Please take my seat.

M: Thanks. Have a nice day.

4번입니다.

다음을 듣고, 남자의 심경을 가장 잘 나타낸 것을 고르세요.

M: I happened to get two free tickets for the musical. I didn't want to miss such a good chance, so I asked Sally to see it with me. It starts at seven o'clock tonight, and we were supposed to meet at 6:30 in front of the theater. However, it's already 6:45 and Sally hasn't come yet. She called me to say she is coming, but I'm afraid that she will not be here in time.

5번입니다.

대화를 듣고, 여자가 주문할 구두의 가격을 고르세요.

W: Look at this website. I've found the shoes I liked so much.

M: Really? Which ones?

W: The same shoes we saw at the department store.

M: Oh, right. As far as I remember, they were one hundred dollars there.

W: Yeah, but they're 15 dollars cheaper on-line!

M: Do they have your size?

W: Yes, they have them in size 7.

M: Then you should buy them.

W: Okay. I'll order them right now.

6번입니다.

다음을 듣고, 여자가 설명하는 것으로 가장 알맞은 것을 고르세요.

W: You can easily find these in the kitchen. They're long and thin, and we use them in pairs. They're usually made of metal, but sometimes they can be made of plastic or wood. They're used for picking up food at the table or even for cooking. It's not easy to use them at first, so you need to practice.

9번입니다.

W: Your receipt says that you bought this over a month ago.

M: That's right. Is there a problem?

M: What? I've never used it and the price tag is still on.

W: I'm sorry, there's nothing I can do, sir. That's our store policy.
