1번 대화를 듣고, 남자가 만든 깃발을 고르시오.

M: Mom, this is the city flag I designed for the Richmond Flag Contest.

W: It looks great! You used trees as a symbol for the city.

M: Yeah, because the city planted many trees this year.

W: That's true, but why didn't you include any sunflowers? A lot of those were planted, too.

M: I know, but I wanted to make my flag unique.

W: I see. I like your idea to put the city name above the trees.

M: Thanks, Mom.

W: Number One

W: Number Two

M: Look at the monster car over there.

W: Oh, it looks so scary.

W: Number Three

M: How long have you been waiting?

W: About half an hour.

W: Number Four

M: Can I see your ticket, please?

W: Here you are.

W: Number Five

M: I'm sorry, but you're not tall enough to ride this.

W: Oh, no! I'm so sad.

M: How about this round one?

W: Round clocks are so common. I think she'd like a square-shaped one.

W: Well, that's nice, but she'd prefer one with a bear. Oh, look at this square one with two bears.

W: My nurse will help you get your medicine before you leave.

M: Thank you.

6번 대화를 듣고, 남자의 심정으로 가장 적절한 것을 고르시오.

M: Mom, have you seen my backpack?

W: Yes, it's getting washed in the washing machine. You asked me to wash it.

M: Oh, no! I should have taken my stuff out of my backpack.

W: What was inside?

M: There was a picture of me and my friends in the pocket.

W: That's too bad. Sorry to hear that.

M: Yeah. I should have been more careful.

7번 다음을 듣고, 두 사람의 대화가 어색한 것을 고르시오.

W: Number One

M: Have you seen my bag?

W: Yes. It's right over there.

W: Number Two

M: How long will it take to get there by taxi?

W: I haven't seen it for a long time.

W: Number Three

M: I'm getting married next month.

W: Congratulations! What is the exact date?

W: Number Four

M: I'm wondering if you could send me the file again.

W: Sure. I will send it as soon as possible.

W: That sounds great!

W: My son and I aren't seated next to each other on the train.

M: So do you want me to change seats with you?

W: Yes, please. My son isn't comfortable not sitting next to me.

M: Okay. No problem. I know what young kids are like.

W: Thank you very much. I really appreciate it.

9번 대화를 듣고, 남자의 마지막 말에 담긴 의도로 가장 적절한 것을 고르시오.

M: Julie, the Halloween party is next week.

W: I know. I need to go shopping for my costume.

M: Me too. Why don't we go to the shopping mall some time?

W: Great idea. How about now? Do you have time?

M: I'd love to, but I have to take my mother to the hospital now.

10번 대화를 듣고, 여자가 지불할 금액을 고르시오.

M: Did you enjoy your meal?

W: Yes. It was great.

M: Thank you. So you had two dishes of spaghetti and one chicken salad.
Your total is \$40.

W: Oh, we didn't order a chicken salad.

M: Let me see. *[pause]* Oh, I'm sorry. I made a mistake.

W: That's okay.

M: So you don't have to pay for the chicken salad, which is \$10.

W: All right. Here's my credit card.
