ANN : 이제 시작하겠습니다.

1번입니다.

대화를 듣고, 대화의 내용에 가장 잘 어울리는 손 모양을 고르세요.

W: What's the weather going to be like this Friday?

M: Well, I want it to be clear and sunny, but the weatherman says it will be cloudy in the morning, and it is likely to be rainy in the afternoon.

W: How can that be? Look! There's not a cloud in the sky.

M: I know. Springtime weather can change so quickly.

W: I hope it doesn't rain. Maybe we should cancel the picnic.

M: No. I've been looking forward to it for days.

W: OK. Well, let's just keep our fingers crossed.

2번입니다.

대화를 듣고, 대화에 언급되지 않은 표지판을 고르세요.

W: What's that sign? It has a picture of two children.

M: That's a crosswalk sign.

W: I see. And what does the one with the bicycle mean?

M: It means you can ride a bicycle there.

W: OK. And that sign?

M: I don't know. What do you think it means?

W: When you see this sign, you can't turn left.

M: Oh, I see.

W: Now, look at that sign. What does that mean?

M: It means you have to stop.

3번입니다.

대화를 듣고, 여자가 치과에 갈 시각을 고르세요.

M: Susan, do you have any plans for this Saturday?

W: Uh, I'm kind of busy. Why do you ask?

M: Oh, I was wondering if we could take a walk down by the lake.

W: I'd love to, but I'm going to be really busy all day on Saturday.

M: What are you going to do on Saturday?

W: First, my mom asked me to help clean the house, and then I need to meet Julie at 11:00 in the morning. Thirty minutes after that, I have an appointment with a dentist.

M: Okay, then are you free after that?

W: Sorry, then I have to pick up my brother from soccer practice at 2:30.

And then I need to go to the grocery store to buy some food at 4:00.

What a busy day!

M: It sounds like you are super busy. Maybe later.

4번입니다.

대화를 듣고, 여자가 목적지까지 가는데 이용할 교통수단을 고르세요.

M: I can't believe this! We have a flat tire!

W: Oh, no. Don't we have a spare tire in the trunk?

M: Yes, we do. But I don't have the tools for changing it.

W: We are already late for the job interview. It's going to be over by the time we get there after fixing the tire.

M: Honey, why don't you take the subway or a bus and go to the job interview by yourself?

W: There is no subway or bus station nearby.

M: I'll call Moon Taxi Service then. They'll get here in a few minutes. I'll catch up with you later.

W: OK. I think we have no choice.

5번입니다.

대화를 듣고, 대화 후 남자가 할 일로 가장 적절한 것을 고르세요.

M: I'm starving. Can I get something to eat?

W: I'm making hamburgers right now.

M: Do you know how to make them?

W: Sure. First, mix the meat, onion, egg, salt and pepper together in a bowl. Then, make round patties and grill them. Next, put each patty on the bread and add a slice of cheese and some vegetables.

M: I see. Is this originally from America?

W: No, this food came from Germany.

M: Interesting. Do you need help?

W: Will you please peel the onions?

M: Sure.

6번입니다.

7번입니다.

대화를 듣고, 여자의 마지막 말의 의도로 가장 알맞은 것을 고르세요.

M : I don't feel very well.

W : Well, I'm not surprised. You don't get enough sleep. And you're working too hard. Sometimes you skip lunch.

M : Yes, you're right. I think I need some rest.

W : And also you stay indoors all the time. You'd better get some exercise.

8번입니다.

대화를 듣고, 남자의 심경으로 가장 알맞은 것을 고르세요.

M: Large? This is a small salad!

W: And this is ice-cream instead of yogurt.

M: The bread is hard, too.

W: And it's not fresh at all. I can't eat it.

M: And I can't drink this wine. It's too warm!

W: Terrible! There's no butter for the bread, either.

M: Where's the waiter?

W: I have no idea. He's probably gone to lunch at another restaurant.

9번입니다.

M: Not yet. I have many things to do tomorrow. I have to clean my room first. Then I have to finish my homework. I also have to take a shower. After that, I'll buy a cake and a present for my friend.

W: Wow, you will be busy tomorrow.

M: Are you free this afternoon?

W: Yes, Why?

M: I heard some new movies were released today. Do you want to see a movie with me?

W: Sounds great.

M: What movie do you want to watch?

W: My favorite movies are science fiction movies. Is there a science fiction movie playing?

M: Sure. There's one starting at 4:30 in the afternoon.

W: I see.

M: Shall we meet at 4 in front of theater number 2?

W: See you then.

W: She likes playing the piano.

W: It's a large black one with my name on it. I tied my handkerchief on the handle.

M: What's inside?

W: There are some clothes in it. I might have some trouble without them.

M: I see. Please fill out this form. Be sure to write your name and phone number. When your suitcase arrives, we will deliver it to you.

We are between the New World Car Center and the Big Shoe Store.

M: How may I help you?

W: How much is this pen?

M: Two dollars.

W: How about a ruler?

M: Four dollars.

W: Please give me three pens and two rulers.

M: Will that be all?

W: Yes, thank you. Here is twenty dollars.

17번입니다.

다음을 듣고, 무엇에 대한 설명인지 고르세요.

W: This is a team sport. Two teams try to score by shooting a ball through a hoop elevated 10 feet above the ground. The game is played on a rectangular floor called the court and there is a hoop at each end. The ball is moved down the court toward the hoop by passing or dribbling. Players try to steal the ball from the other team and make shots, using only their hands. When players put the ball through the hoop, they will get points.
