ANN: 이제 시작하겠습니다.

1번 대화를 듣고, 두 사람이 보고 있는 로봇을 고르시오.

M: Jenny, look at this. This robot won the first prize in the robot design contest.
W: It looks like a spider.
M: Doesn't it? Real spiders have eight legs, but this one has just four legs.
W: What is on top of it?
M: It's a video camera.
W: Interesting!
M: This robot can be sent to dangerous places and record what's there.

2번 대화를 듣고, 남자가 발표시간을 변경해야 하는 이유로 가장 적절한 것을 고르시오.

M: Ms. Williams, do you have a minute to talk about the seminar next Thursday?
W: Sure.
M: I wonder if I could change my presentation time from 3 p.m. to 10 a.m.
