1번 대화를 듣고, 여자가 주문할 상자를 고르시오.

M: What are you doing on the computer, Julia?

W: I'm looking for a box for the chocolate I made for my mom's birthday.

M: Let's see... I like this heart-shaped box.

W: Hmm. Not bad, but isn't it too simple?

M: Well, then how about the heart-shaped one with stars? It looks fancy.

W: Oh, look! Here's a bear-shaped one with a ribbon.

M: Wow, that's pretty!

W: I think so, too. I'll order that one.

2번 대화를 듣고, 남자가 음반 가게를 방문한 목적으로 가장 적절한 것을 고르시오.

W: What can I do for you?

M: I bought this CD yesterday for my friend. But she has one already!

W: Would you like to exchange it for a different CD?

M: I'd rather just get a refund.

W: Well, you can get a free gift if you buy the new special album of JC Band.

3번 다음 그림의 상황에 가장 적절한 대화를 고르시오.

M: Number One

M: We're having beef steak.

M: Number Two

W: Excuse me. This isn't what I ordered.

M: Number Three

W: What's today's special?

M: Vegetable spaghetti with mushroom soup.

M: Number Four

W: Have you finished cleaning the table, honey?

M: Of course, I have. And I'm washing the dishes now.

M: Number Five

W: Do you know where the food court is in this building?

M: I'm afraid not. It's my first time here.

4번 대화를 듣고, 남자가 구입할 의자를 고르시오.

M: I'm looking for a chair for my daughter.

W: How about this one with four wheels? It's very popular among students.

M: Oh, my daughter is only five years old. I like this square one.

W: But it might be dangerous for five-year-olds because it doesn't have a back. How about this one?

M: Good. The crown shape looks unique. How much is it?

W: It's \$30.

M: Okay, I'll take it.

6번 대화를 듣고, 여자의 심정으로 가장 적절한 것을 고르시오.

M: Why don't you exchange them for a larger size?

W: I can't. I've already washed them once.

W: I doubt it. I wish I hadn't bought them.

W: Number Five

W: I can't. I have to study for my math test.

8번 대화를 듣고, 남자가 여자에게 부탁한 일로 가장 적절한 것을 고르시오.

W: Hi, Steve. You look busy these days.

M: I'm preparing for a presentation in my Korean class.

W: What are you going to talk about?

M: I've decided to talk about cultural differences.

W: Did you write a script?

M: I did, but it took me so much time to write it in Korean.

W: Do you need any help?

M: Yes. Would you read the script and correct any errors?

W: Sure, no problem.

9번 대화를 듣고, 남자의 마지막 말에 담긴 의도로 가장 적절한 것을 고르시오.

M: I finally finished my science project, Ms. Brown.

W: Great! I'm proud of you, Tom.

M: I couldn't have finished it without your encouragement.

W: I know how hard you've been working on the project.

M: I don't know how to thank you enough for your help.

10번 대화를 듣고, 남자가 지불할 금액을 고르시오.

M: Excuse me. How much is that red shirt?

W: How about this blue one? It's only \$30.

M: I like the design. Do you have the same shirt in green as well?

W: Yes. And if you buy two in this design, you get \$5 off of the total.

W: Okay.
