ANN: 이제 시작하겠습니다.

1번 대화를 듣고, 두 사람이 하고 있는 동작을 고르시오.

W: Let's take a break. We've been sitting too long.

M: Hey, I learned some stretches. This will help. First, put your right hand behind your head like this.

W: Okay. Now what?

M: Then, hold your right elbow with your left hand. And gently pull your elbow to the left.

W: Oh, I feel the stretch in my muscles.

M: Hold it for 10 seconds and then do it again.

M: It begins next Monday.

M: Number Five

W: These shoes feel so loose. Could you show me another pair?

M: Sure. Let me go get them for you.

W: Hello, Justin! What's up?

M: Hi, Linda. I heard you're transferring to a new school next Friday.

W: Yeah, that's true. I'll miss you.

M: Me, too. Why don't we have lunch together this Saturday?

W: Sorry, but I have to help my parents pack stuff during the weekend. What about on Monday?

M: Okay. I'll see you at the school cafeteria at noon.

5번 대화를 듣고, 두 사람이 대화하고 있는 장소로 가장 적절한 곳을 고르시오.

W: Dad, look! There's a parrot.

M: Oh, it looks so real.

W: Yeah. It even sounds like a parrot. That's great.

M: It also has colorful feathers though they're made of plastic.

W: Dad, can you buy me this one?

M: Okay. It's your birthday. If that's what you want, I'll buy it for you.

W: Thanks, Dad.

M: Sumi, why didn't you hand in your homework?

W: What? I emailed it last Friday.

M: You just wrote your name and student number with no attached file.

W: Oh, I'm so sorry. I didn't know that. Can I send the file this afternoon?

M: I'm afraid that's not possible. The deadline was last Friday.

W: Oh, no! I can't believe that I made such a big mistake.

7번 다음을 듣고, 두 사람의 대화가 어색한 것을 고르시오.

W: Number One

M: How would you like to pay?

W: By credit card.

W: Number Two

M: I was disappointed with the film.

W: You were? I felt the same way.

W: Number Three

M: This jacket is too big for me.

M: When do you think we can finish the project?

W: I don't know whether you like it or not.

W: Number Five

M: You look so pretty! Is that a new dress?

W: Yes. It's a birthday gift from my mom.

8번 대화를 듣고, 여자가 남자에게 부탁한 일로 가장 적절한 것을 고르시오.

M: Helen, I've heard the movie, *The Man from Somewhere*, is a box-office hit. Have you seen it?

W: No, not yet.

M: Why don't we go see it Friday night?

W: I'd love to, but I wonder if there are tickets available.

M: I can check for tickets with my cellphone right now. *[pause]* Oh, there are still a few left.

W: That's good. Can you book them for us? Then, I'll buy some popcorn.

M: That sounds perfect.

9번 대화를 듣고, 여자의 마지막 말에 담긴 의도로 가장 적절한 것을 고르시오.

M: Honey, I have a special present for you. Please close your eyes.

W: Okay. What is it?

M: Now open your eyes and look at this.

W: Wow! It's a new bookshelf. Did you make it yourself?

M: Of course! You're such a bookworm. I hope you like it.

W: Yeah, I love it. There couldn't be a better present for me.

10번 대화를 듣고, 여자가 지불할 금액을 고르시오.

M: Did you enjoy your meal?

W: Yes, very much. Thank you. How much do I owe you?

M: You had the T-bone steak, french fries, and a salad. So your total is 30 dollars.

W: That's with a 50 percent discount, right?

M: Yes, the regular price for the same meal is 60 dollars. This is the price of the discounted lunch special.

W: Thank you. It was delicious. Here's my credit card.
