ANN: 이제 시작하겠습니다.

1번 대화를 듣고, 여자가 구입할 마스크를 고르시오.

M: Hello. How may I help you?

W: Hi, I'd like to buy a face mask for my son.

M: Okay. What about this one with cars on it? It's popular among boys.

W: It's nice, but do you have any with animals?

M: Yes, we do. How about this one with rabbits?

W: Not bad, but do you have any with more than one animal on it?

M: Yes. How about this one with rabbits and monkeys?

W: Great! I'll take it!

2번 대화를 듣고, 남자가 여자에게 전화한 목적으로 가장 적절한 것을 고르시오.

*[Cell phone rings.]*

W: Hello, Dad.

M: Alice, I'm still waiting for your decision.

W: Sorry it took so long. My answer is "Yes."

M: Great. I'm glad we'll be able to join the Grandma's birthday party together.

W: Me too. I told my friends that I can't go to the concert with them that day.

M: Good. Grandma will be so happy to see you. I'll book our train tickets to Busan.

3번 다음 그림의 상황에 가장 적절한 대화를 고르시오.

**M: Number One**

W: James, the curtain is so dirty.

M: Okay. Let's wash it then.

**M: Number Two**

W: Honey, would you close the curtain?

M: Sure, I'll do that for you.

**M: Number Three**

W: Oh, it's raining outside!

M: I'll go get an umbrella for you.

**M: Number Four**

W: This is such a lovely curtain.

M: Thank you. I bought it last month.

**M: Number Five**

W: Do you know how to hang a curtain?

M: I'm afraid I've never done that before.

4번 대화를 듣고, 두 사람이 구입할 케이크를 고르시오.

W: Honey, look at this cake. Isn't the star beautiful?

M: It's nice, but I'm not sure if Mark will like it.

W: Then, how about this one with a snowman?

M: It's good too, but I think Mark would like one with animals more.

W: Okay. Then we should choose either the one with a polar bear or a penguin.

M: I think Mark would prefer the polar bear to the penguin.

W: I agree. Let's buy it.

5번 대화를 듣고, 남자의 직업으로 가장 적절한 것을 고르시오.

W: Hello.

M: Hi. May I help you?

W: Yes. A week ago, I checked out this book, and I'd like to keep it one more week. Is that possible?

M: Let me check. *[pause]* Yes, you can. There is no one on the waiting list.

W: Great. And can you tell me where the earth science books are?

M: They're in section D, on the second floor.

W: Thank you.

6번 대화를 듣고, 여자의 심정으로 가장 적절한 것을 고르시오.

M: Hi, Nancy. Looks like you're in a hurry.

W: Yeah. I'm on my way to get my phone back.

M: Did you leave it somewhere?

W: Yes, I did. I left it in a taxi last night.

M: Oh, my! Did you call your phone after you realized that?

W: Yeah. The taxi driver answered and said he'd return it to me. He's at the school gate now.

M: How nice! You're very lucky to get it back.

7번 다음을 듣고, 두 사람의 대화가 어색한 것을 고르시오.

**W: Number One**

M: Would you like something to drink?

W: Just water, please. Thank you.

**W: Number Two**

M: I lost my watch yesterday.

W: Oh, sorry to hear that.

**W: Number Three**

M: What did you do last Monday?

W: I watched a movie with my friend.

**W: Number Four**

M: Ron is absent today because he is sick.

W: Right. He wants to be a doctor.

**W: Number Five**

M: Do you mind if I sit here?

W: Sorry. This seat is already taken.

8번 대화를 듣고, 남자가 여자에게 부탁한 일로 가장 적절한 것을 고르시오.

*[Cell phone rings.]*

W: Hello.

M: Hi, Sue. Are you on your way to the baseball park?

W: Yes, I'm on the bus. Where are you?

M: I'm standing in line to buy tickets.

W: Oh, really? I'll be there in 10 minutes.

M: Okay. Can you buy some snacks? I skipped lunch. I'm really hungry.

W: Sure, no problem. I'll buy some.

9번 대화를 듣고, 여자의 마지막 말에 담긴 의도로 가장 적절한 것을 고르시오.

W: Kevin, you look so happy in this picture!

M: Yes, I was. I had so much fun during the global camp. This French boy was my best friend there.

W: He looks nice.

M: He is. He helped me a lot during the team activities. I really miss him.

W: Why don't you send this picture to him by e-mail?

10번 대화를 듣고, 남자가 지불할 금액을 고르시오.

W: Hello. Welcome to King Fishing.

M: Hi. I'd like to fish here with my son. How much is it?

W: \$30 for adults. How old is your son?

M: He's seven years old.

W: Then, his admission is free. Would you like to rent fishing chairs?

M: Yes. Two chairs, please.

W: Okay. They're \$5 each.

M: Great. Here's the money.

11번 대화를 듣고, 두 사람이 대화하고 있는 장소로 가장 적절한 곳을 고르시오.

M: Honey, this trip is going to be so refreshing.

W: Definitely. I'm so excited to be here.

M: What beautiful scenery!

W: For sure. Well, let's set up the tent before it gets dark.

M: Okay. Let's make sure the tent is not close to the fire area.

W: Good point. After we set up the tent, I'll prepare dinner.

M: All right. Sounds great.

12번 다음을 듣고, Central City Museum에 관해 언급되지 않은 것을 고르시오.

W: Hello, listeners. Have you ever visited Central City Museum? The museum first opened in 1973. It is located next to the City Hall. It has five exhibition rooms and a gift shop. The museum is open daily from 9 a.m. to 6 p.m. Ticket prices are \$30 for adults and \$10 for children. If you have any questions, please visit the Central City Museum website.

13번 다음 표를 보면서 대화를 듣고, 내용과 일치하지 않는 것을 고르시오.

W: Honey, I'd like to sell Ben's old bike on the Internet. Can you help me fill out the form?

M: Sure. The brand name is Apollo.

W: Okay.

M: And the wheel size is twelve inches.

W: All right.

M: And it's green. What condition do you think it's in?

W: I'd say excellent. Ben rarely rode it.

M: Hmm.... Then I think we can ask \$60 for it.

14번 다음을 듣고, 무엇에 관한 설명인지 고르시오.

M: This is used to slow down a person falling through the air. It enables a person to jump from an aircraft and land on the ground safely. It consists of a large piece of thin cloth attached to a person's body by strings. It is mostly used in emergency situations or in the military, but people also use it for leisure.

15번 대화를 듣고, 여자가 대화 직후에 할 일로 가장 적절한 것을 고르시오.

M: Kaylee, we're going to be late for the movie.

W: Sorry, Dad. I was looking for my glasses.

M: I've told you so many times to put them in the same place.

M: Come on. Mom's waiting for us outside.

W: Okay. I'll just quickly go get it.

16번 대화를 듣고, 회사 야유회를 가기로 한 날짜를 고르시오.

W: Jack, we should decide on a date for our company picnic.

M: Okay, Jean. How about June 2nd or June 7th?

W: I think we need a couple more days than that to prepare for it. How about June 9th?

M: We already have a weekly meeting planned on that day at 10 o'clock.

W: I'm sure we can reschedule the meeting.

M: Okay, then let's go with your suggested date.

17번 다음 상황 설명을 듣고, Chris가 Anna에게 할 말로 가장 적절한 것을 고르시오.

W: Chris takes his friend Anna to his favorite Italian restaurant for dinner, but he didn't make a reservation. He sees many people waiting to get a table. The waiter is writing people's names on a waiting list. Chris really wants to eat with Anna at this restaurant, so he decides to ask Anna if she doesn't mind waiting. In this situation, what would Chris most likely say to Anna?

18번 대화를 듣고, 남자가 할 일로 가장 적절한 것을 고르시오.

M: Mom, I've decided what to get Jenny for her birthday.

W: What did you decide on?

M: I think I'll get her a wallet.

W: Good idea. What kind of wallet do you have in mind?

M: I saw a nice one at the mall. I took a picture of it with my cell phone.

W: Did you? Can I see it?

M: Sure. Wait a second.

19번 대화를 듣고, 상황을 가장 잘 표현한 속담을 고르시오.

M: Jane, how was the science competition last weekend?

W: It was a disaster. My team members couldn't work together.

M: What do you mean?

W: All of them thought that their ideas were the best, and they wouldn't listen to anybody else's ideas.

M: That's too bad. So you didn't do well in the competition.

W: Actually, we didn't even finish our project before the deadline.

M: That was terrible.

20번 대화를 듣고, 여자의 마지막 말에 대한 남자의 응답으로 가장 적절한 것을 고르시오.

M: How can I help you, Ma'am?

W: I'd like to get a refund for this dress I bought here. Here's the receipt.

M: Hmm... your receipt shows that you bought this item three weeks ago.

W: That's right. Is that a problem?

M: I'm afraid so. You can only get a refund for goods within two weeks from the date of purchase. It's clearly written on the receipt.
