1번 대화를 듣고, 남자가 만든 눈사람을 고르시오.

M: Grandma, look at this picture. I made a snowman with Paul.

W: Good job. I like the scarf around its neck.

M: It's Paul's. And he brought the carrot for a nose, too.

W: I see. Are the eyes stones?

M: Yes. And we used sticks from a tree for the arms.

W: It looks like a real man. But it might look better with a hat.

M: I know, but we couldn't find any.

2번 대화를 듣고, 선생님이 Kevin을 꾸짖은 이유로 가장 적절한 것을 고르시오.
