ANN : 이제 시작하겠습니다.

1번입니다.

다음을 듣고, 내용에 알맞은 그림을 고르세요.

[W] First, stand on your right foot with the leg slightly bent. Second, bend your left knee with the leg raised. Third, bend your right arm and raise it over your head, and then put your left arm straight next to your body but slightly detached.

2번입니다.

다음을 듣고, 비행기 출발예정 시각과 탑승구가 알맞게 짝지어진 것을 고르세요.

[A] Attention passengers! United Airline 123 bound for L.A. at 1 p.m. will be delayed due to heavy yellow dust. W : What? A travel agent? This is Shanghai restaurant.

8번입니다.
