**1번 대화를 듣고, 여자가 받은 장바구니를 고르시오.**

W: Honey, I got this eco-friendly shopping bag from the grocery store for free.

M: Oh, great! It has a pocket on it.

M: I see. It's nice that the bag has a button.

W: For sure. That'll be useful to keep groceries inside the bag.
