ANN: 이제 시작하겠습니다.

1번 다음을 듣고, 홍콩의 오후 날씨로 가장 적절한 것을 고르시오.

M: Good morning! Here is today's weather report for Asia. There is a strong wind in Seoul because of the rainstorm from the south. In Tokyo, it's cloudy now after the rain stopped this morning. Let's go to Hongkong. It is raining now, but it is going to be sunny this afternoon. Thank you.

2번 대화를 듣고, 남자가 보고 있는 그림으로 가장 적절한 것을 고르시오.

M: Sarah. How's your drawing going?

W: I'm still working on it, Mr. Park.

M: Let me see... Oh, you're drawing a beach.

W: Yes. At first, I only drew the beach and my family. But, the picture looked too simple.

M: I see. So you added trees to it. Is it from your memory?

W: It is. My family went to Jeju island last weekend and saw a beautiful beach there. So, I wanted to draw this picture.

M: Oh, okay then. I'll have a coke as well.

6번 대화를 듣고, 여자의 마지막 말의 의도로 가장 적절한 것을 고르시오.

W: Jiho, you look upset. What's wrong?
