1번입니다.

대화를 듣고, 여자가 사려고 하는 물건을 고르세요.

M: Hello. May I help you?

W: Yes, please. I'm looking for a birthday present for my brother.

M: What does he like?

W: He likes to exercise in his free time.

M: Let me see. We have jump-ropes and dumbbells, and if he likes sports, we also have tennis rackets, basketballs and baseball gloves.

W: Oh, I found something he needs. He's interested in getting stronger nowadays. I'll buy him some equipment for weight training.

2번입니다.

대화를 듣고, 남자가 전화를 건 목적을 고르세요.

W: Good afternoon, this is the Paradise. May I help you?

W: Sure, how many are in your party?

M: Six. Four adults and two kids. And could we have a table in the non-smoking section?
