ANN : 이제 시작하겠습니다.

1번입니다.

대화를 듣고, 남자의 여자 친구를 고르세요.

W: Jeff, what are you looking at?

M: I'm looking at the picture I took on my graduation day. My girlfriend is there, too. Can you guess who she is?

W: Hmm. Let me see. Is she the one with short curly hair?

M: No. She has long curly hair.

W: But there are three girls with long curly hair. Is she wearing a hat?

M: No.

W: Oh, I think I know. This thin tall girl is your girlfriend, right?

M: You got it.

2번입니다.

대화를 듣고, 여자가 경찰에 단속된 이유를 고르세요.

M: May I see your license, please?

W: Sure. Here it is.

M: Ma'am, this is your student ID card. I need to see your driver's license.

W: OK. But... but why? My seat belt is fastened. What did I do wrong?

M: Do you always drive this fast? You were doing sixty miles an hour.
