1번 다음을 듣고, 예상되는 런던의 날씨로 가장 적절한 것을 고르시오.

M: Good evening! Here is today's world weather report. Today in Seoul, the rain is expected to continue from last night. In New York, there will be showers and thunderstorms all day long. The forecast for Paris is mostly cloudy. Snow is expected for London. Thank you very much.
