1. 대화를 듣고, 두 사람이 사용할 표지판을 고르시오. [1점]

W: Tom, what are you doing on the computer?

M: I'm making a sign for our photo exhibition for the front gate.

W: For the front gate? Then the arrow should point to the right, not to the left.

M: Oh, you're right. I made a mistake.

W: Also, put the arrow on the top, not the bottom.

M: Hmm... I think it looks better on the bottom. I'll leave it the way it is.

W: Okay. And why don't you add the distance to the exhibition hall?

M: Do you think it's really necessary? It's not far from the front gate.
